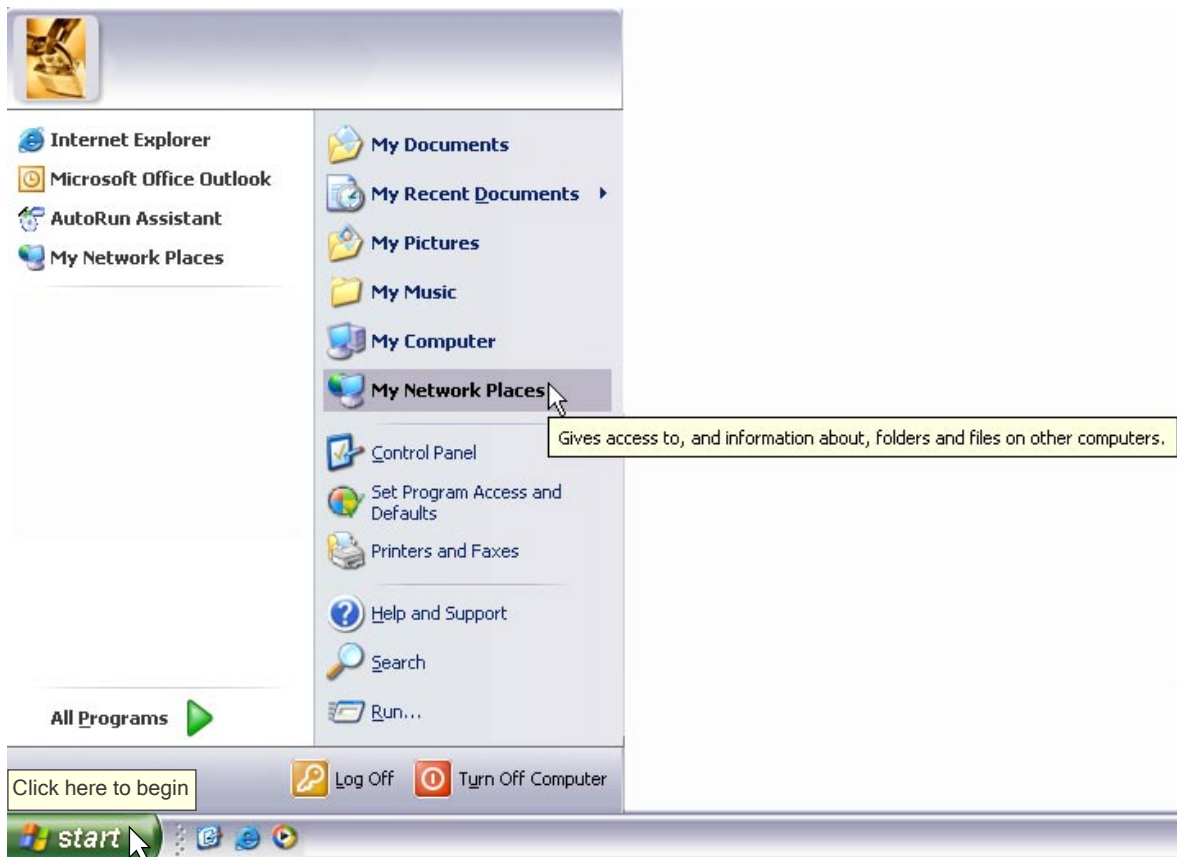


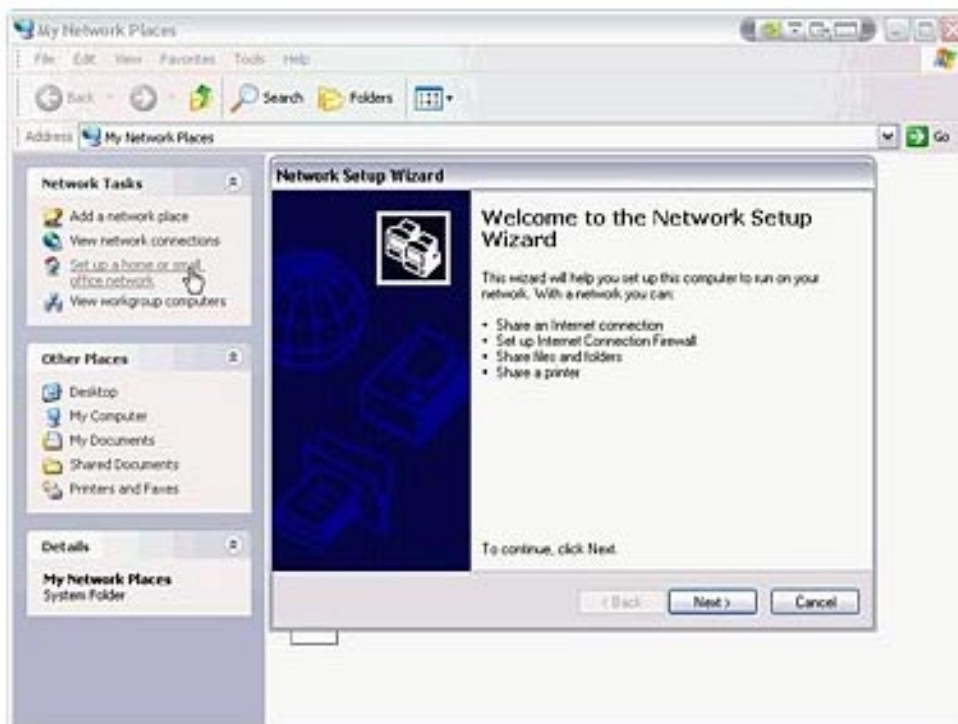
## Internet Connection Sharing Windows XP

*When this is the PC with  
the internet connection*



## Step One

Click on 'Start' in taskbar (bottom left hand side), choose 'My Network Places'.



## Step Two

Choose Set Up a Home or Small Office Network. In the Welcome Screen (above) click Next



### Step Three

Read the Screen then click Next.



### Step Four

Make sure to check the correct option as above. Click Next.
